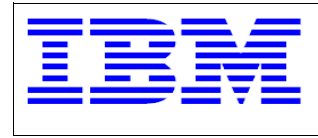

ESSAY GUIDELINES:

1. Write Rap or Spoken Word with a maximum of 250 words. This must be typed in a Microsoft Word document.
2. Contestants must be a current student in the Virgin Islands Department of Education public school system in grades 7th or 8th.
3. All submissions in writing must be **received by Mon. May 3rd, 2010.**
4. All participants will be judged by a panel from the LifeStyle Festival/Healthy Encores along with members of the Stop the Bleeding organization at the Health Awareness Day on both islands.
5. Awards will be presented to the student winners, accompanied by their principal and families, at the [U.S. Virgin Islands Lifestyle Festival Health Awareness Day, Friday July 23, 2010 in St. Croix and Saturday, July 24, 2010 in St. Thomas.](#)
6. First place winners will receive an iPod and a chance to participate in the Stop the Bleeding commercial. Performance of the winners at the LifeStyle Festival contest on Saturday evening July 24th is optional.
